

FAITH COMMUNITIES ACTIVITIES REPORTS 2017-18

The State Government provides funding to SHV through Safer Care Victoria for the development and provision of spiritual care services in Victorian health services (metropolitan and regional). Funding, based on the 2016 Census figures, is disbursed to the faith communities who are members of SHV to enable their provision of spiritual care services. Faith communities are required to provide annual reports accounting for funding expenditure.

The contribution of the faith communities to health services exceeds the funding received from Government. The following tables detail the hospitals receiving services and the personnel involved in providing chaplaincy and pastoral care.
